- The sale will be governed by the following terms & conditions: 4.
- (i) The tenderer is required to pay EMD of ₹5000/- per vehicle.
- EMD is payable in the form of Demand Draft from any Nationalised Bank in favour of (ii) DDO, DIPAM. Quotations received without EMD will not be considered and shall not be accepted. The EMD will be returned to unsuccessful tenderers at the earliest. The EMD will be returned to successful tenderer, after getting the payment in the form of Demand Draft in favour of DDO, DIPAM from the tenderer and finalization of sale.
